There are four other churches involved this year: St. Mark's Lutheran Church, on 3/20, St. James the Baptist Church on 3/27, the Polish National Catholic Church on 4/3, and Holy Family Church on 4/10. The services last about forty minutes and are followed by refreshments. Please come for the first one especially since we are its hosts.

A Brazilian Community has been having Sunday Mass in our church for almost ten years now. One of their members, Marcelo Carneiro, is sick and the community is raising money to help defray his medical expenses. If you would like to buy a raffle ticket (\$10.00), that would be very kind of you. They will be available after Masses as well as at the rectory during office hours.

We are also sponsoring two other activities during Lent: the Spiritual Exercises of Saint Ignatius of Loyola and a Day of Retreat on Saturday, the 29th of March. Fr. William C.
