Many of you know Anne and Tom Flood. Until three years ago they were very much on the scene here in our parish. They were the major cooks for all our communal meals and contributed in many other ways to the parish. Tom retired about three years ago. They then bought a house in Florida. But almost immediately Tom became ill with a disease called Progressive Supranuclear Palsy, or PSP for short. It affects balance, speech, vision, cognition and swallowing. At first Tom was forced to seek help in different rehab locations here in the area, but finally Anne and he went south. Since then his health has deteriorated drastically. Anne still has him at home but has help coming in. She is now very much involved in raising funds for research into a possible cure for this disease.

Please support her in this effort. There is a walk on April 5th at Marco Island. We have helped her in the past. We hope to continue to do so this year. The cure will come too late for Tom, but it will help others in the future.
