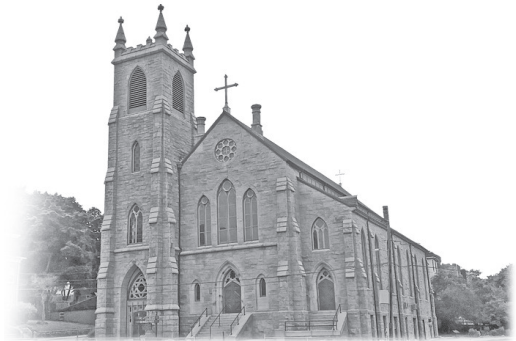

Padre's Ponderings

In this space each week, I hope to keep open a line of communication with the parishioners of Saint Charles and All Saints. It will also provide me with an opportunity to share random "ponderings" on matters that concern us as a parish family, as a local community and as members of the wider Church.

First and foremost, I am so very grateful for the warm and gracious welcome I have received since my arrival. In even a short time among you, it has become clear that both dedication and generosity of service are abundant among the parishioners, staff and volunteers of both of our parishes. That makes me all the more eager to get to work *with* you and *for* you. As I said last weekend, my operative principle in the coming weeks will be to listen more than I speak! I am willing to listen and learn so that I can assess what pastoral needs exist and how they can best be met.

A few practical notes:

- My intention is to keep the present weekend and daily Mass schedule for the time being. I will celebrate the 4pm Mass at our parishes on alternating weeks. Fr. Hunt will continue to celebrate the 4pm at Saint Charles when I am at All Saints, and Fr. Desaulniers will continue to assist with the 4pm at All Saints when I am at Saint Charles. I will celebrate all Sunday Masses at both parishes each weekend with the exception of the 12nn liturgy, which Fr. Sweet has graciously agreed to continue to preside over, with the capable help of Deacon Jose and Lakesha. While I cannot guarantee the long-term tenability of this arrangement, my intention is to keep things as they are for now.
- I know things typically slow down in parishes over the summer, but please remember that so much good work continues to go on here. The services provided in our parish communities for the poor, the sick, the homeless, and those in recovery, continue to be depended upon even "off season." Many thanks to all those who make those services possible and keep them going.
- After two full weekends with you, I am impressed by the quality and dedication of the musicians at both parishes, as well as the expert assistance provided by the servers, extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion, readers and ushers. If anyone is willing to serve in any of our liturgical ministries, please do not hesitate to introduce yourself to me. Help is always needed and the more the merrier!
- In the coming weeks and months, I hope to focus on reviewing and improving what I will be calling the "Sunday experience" at All Saints and Saint Charles. Some questions I hope to explore with you so that we can become an even more welcoming and engaging community: If I were a first-time visitor to a typical weekend Mass at All Saints or Saint Charles, what would my first impressions be? Would I feel welcomed without being intimidated and engaged without being patronized? Would I want to come back? Why or why not? Would I be inclined to tell family or friends about my experience and encourage them to attend? That's just a start, but keep those questions in mind as we move forward in assessing both our strengths and weaknesses. And know that I am always open to feedback.

Thank you again for "bearing the heat of the day" as a parish community throughout these last several months and for remaining faithful. There's no doubt that these are not easy days to be Catholic, but if we remain faithful to Christ and to each other, his grace will accomplish in us and through us far more than we could ever ask or imagine.
