Padre's Ponderings


A few snapshots from this week:

- I have been visiting with our parishioners who are in nursing homes. While they may not be able to get to church anymore, they are still very much a part of our parish family! One woman, beaming from ear to ear, wept as I gave her Holy Communion. Afterward, through tears, she explained how much she desired to receive Jesus in the Eucharist and how grateful she was that he had answered her prayer. What faith that woman has! She knows that the most important desire of our hearts should be communion with Jesus, present to us in the Blessed Sacrament. I hope to address the needs of our nursing home residents and homebound parishioners in the near future, perhaps by engaging some volunteers in making routine visits on behalf of the parish. If any of you have any thoughts about that, please don't hesitate to reach out.
- I've been able to meet with the finance councils and trustees from both parishes. I am impressed by the sheer amount of
 experience, talent, wisdom and skill possessed by the members of those councils and I am eager to work with them and
 with our financial administrator, Christine Daneault, in the coming weeks and months.
- I was able to meet last week with my brother Knights of Columbus, including leadership from the Woonsocket Council. I am so pleased to be in a community where the Knights are so actively present and engaged. I look forward to working with them and I know that we owe them a great debt of gratitude for all the good they do, both seen and unseen.
- We've had a few technical issues with both air conditioning and telecommunications at All Saints. We are in the process of calibrating the timer for the air conditioning in the church and we are addressing the lack of telephone accessibility. Apologies for any discomfort or confusion either of those issues may have caused. We also recently contracted a vendor to repair the front steps of All Saints Church and are hopeful that the work will be completed before winter. We'll be able to remove the unsightly chain and post barriers to make our church even safer and more attractive to members and newcomers alike.
