Padre's Ponderings

All Saints Updates:

A few weeks back, Pauline Leclerc and I went through the church and did some rearranging and reorganizing. In addition to providing a more prominent place for some of the images of our saints, we also moved the baptismal font and candle back to the entrance of the church. Placing the font at the door reminds us that it is through baptism that the door of faith is opened to us and our journey of discipleship begins. Not only will children and others be welcomed into the faith and into our parish family at that font, but at Masses of Christian Burial, water will be taken from that font and sprinkled on the casket of the deceased to remind us that the final journey we make from this life to the next is also defined by our baptismal identity. Anyone coming and going from our church building can use water from the font to mark themselves with the sign of the cross. Thanks, Pauline, for your help and advice with the moving and rearranging! And speaking of Pauline, I am deeply grateful for her guidance and her support during my first few weeks here. We are busy working on a schedule for the upcoming religious education season and we are excited about implementing a monthly Family Liturgy once the school year is underway. More on that in the future!

Saint Charles Updates:

As magnificent as our old stone church is, I am more and more impressed by the devotion of the "living stones" who make up our parish family. I'm particularly grateful to the Kilcline family who wear many hats! Whether making sure the temperature in the church or basement is where it should be, or leading our congregation in song through beautiful music, or watering the planters at the front of the church, or picking up trash on our property, they truly do it all! Many thanks to Wayne, Becky, Liam and Owen for embodying stewardship in such a palpable way! And be on the lookout for snapshots in upcoming bulletins about other "living stones" from our parish community without whom we would not be who we are.

Updates on the Spanish-Speaking Community:

I had an opportunity last week to meet with the leaders of the Spanish community. I told them a few things: (1) I am here to assess their pastoral needs and to determine how best their needs are being met, (2) I wanted them to know that they are just as much a part of our parish family as any other group, and that means that they will continue to have generous access to our facilities and meeting spaces, (3) I do not want to take over or reinvent any of the wonderful programs or activities that they have already undertaken, I just want to be able to encourage the dedicated leadership that is already in place and help everyone work together for the growth and strength of the community, (4) Deacon Jose, Lakesha and I will work together as a team to help make sure that despite my inability to communicate in Spanish, I will still be able to understand what needs exist and how they might best be met, and lastly, (5) I recognize that generosity is exhibited in a number of ways, not just financially. I was so moved to discover that members of the Hispanic Legion of Mary faithfully clean All Saints Church every week as part of their stewardship commitment. So many others engage in acts of charity, visits to the elderly and homebound, the education of youth in the faith, and our vibrant music ministry, among many other forms of service. The Spanish-speaking community at All Saints is generous with their time and talent, and I am exceedingly grateful!
