

**PARKING LOT REPAIR - Update -** As all of you know, three of the trees in the lot were removed earlier this summer as the first step in repairing the parking lot. Depending upon the weather and scheduling, the next step is the long overdue repair to the parking lot fence. This work will begin shortly. In this phase, the broken and damaged pole will be replaced; the chain-link fencing will be straightened, and the two entrances from North Main Street will be widened by an additional three feet. Once that work has been completed, we will probably be asking for volunteers to help paint the fence.

The cost for the tree removal and fence repair is approximately \$4,700. If you would like to help defray the financial burden of these repairs, please drop your donation in an envelope in with the regular weekly collection. The final and most costly phase of the parking lot repair is the repaving of the lot. We have reviewed bids from several contractors that range from \$45,000 - \$70,000 for this project. We are also looking at the practicality of repairing only those areas in greatest disrepair.
