We know that Pauline managed to keep our parish cared for and growing in the absence of a full-time priest, and we can never adequately express our gratitude to her for all that she has done. The very weekend that I began here, I stopped into a local restaurant for dinner and a random couple sat next to me. When they found out that I was the new priest here, they shared how significant an impact Pauline had on their son during his preparation for Confirmation. They credited her with keeping him engaged with the faith at a time when most young people are not connecting with the Church. I was delighted to hear that, and it made me excited to have the opportunity to work with Pauline in the pastoral care of our parish. How disappointed I am that our time together has been so short. But even in the past month, she has generously and patiently worked with me to help me get adjusted. I know that because we have worked so well together over the last several weeks, and would have worked well together in the future, she is comfortable passing over the reins so she can enjoy well-deserved time with family and friends in retirement. As a parish family, we owe Pauline a debt of gratitude that can never be fully repaid. But we will do our best. Pauline will be honored with a special Mass and reception in the Fall. We will keep you posted on details in the near future. Pauline is truly irreplaceable, but I am fully committed to continuing and growing the ministries—especially to the youth and the poor—that she has been so selflessly devoted to throughout her time among us. Pauline, on behalf of the countless people whose lives you have touched from our parish community and well beyond its borders, thank you! I can think of no one more deserving of the affirmation of our Lord himself from sacred scripture than you, Pauline. “Well done, good and faithful servant!” Ad multos annos!

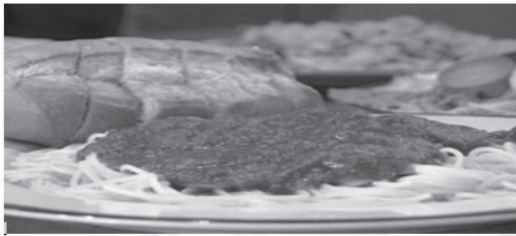

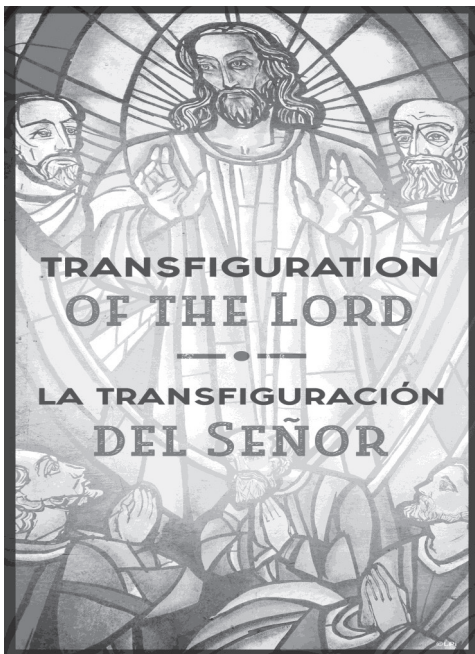
