

PADRE'S PONDERINGS

We were shocked to wake up on Sunday morning to discover that just hours after a deadly mass shooting in El Paso. another had taken place in Dayton. We need to be careful to not become desensitized to these horrific acts of violence, the causes of which are so complex and need to be studied and remedied by those responsible for addressing them. But we also needn't give up on prayer simply in an effort to emphasize action. As disciples of Jesus, we still believe that our earnest prayers for others are effective, that God hears the cries of his people and changes hearts and minds in answer to our prayers. Let us never give up on praying, even when action is also needed. Our world needs God and the healing grace that only he can give. So without becoming anxious or despairing about the state of the world, and without needing to give in to an unhealthy activism, we can take courage that God's grace is stronger than even the most horrific acts of violence and hatred.

I've spent the last few weeks getting acquainted with parishioners of All Saints and Saint Charles who are in nursing homes or are homebound. It has been a pleasure to meet with them and to witness their ongoing dedication to our parish communities. I'm also exceedingly grateful for the members of our parish communities who provide pastoral care as friendly visitors and extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion. If visiting the homebound or nursing home residents is a ministry you'd like to participate in, please speak with me. Like all of our ministries, the more the merrier! Our dedicated readers, extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion, altar servers and greeters would all love to expand their ranks. Just talk to me after Mass if you're interested. Training is always provided.

Next week, we will welcome representatives from the **Franciscan Missionaries of Mary** for the annual diocesan **Mission Co-op Appeal**. Each year, we are given an opportunity to learn about the good work of religious orders and dioceses throughout the world, and how we might support them. It's always good to get a sense of the working of the wider Church, and I know that we will be generous and hospitable to our guests.

All Saints Updates:

You'll notice that the celebrant's and deacon's chairs are now occupying a different space. This enables not only a closer proximity to the congregation, but it also enables the priest and deacon to hear much more clearly the readings being proclaimed from the ambo. Having the altar of reservation with the tabernacle unobscured by seating also reminds us that the center of our parish and of every liturgy is Jesus. He is the heart of all we do and are as a parish family. I'm grateful to John Levreault for overseeing our sound system and for helping us obtain some much-needed new equipment so that the priest and deacon will be heard loudly and clearly from their new location. You'll also notice that from now on, the reader will carry the **Book of the Gospels** during the entrance procession of every Mass and place it on the altar. Highlighting the Book of the Gospels in this way reminds us that whenever the gospel is proclaimed at Mass, it is Christ himself who proclaims it to us.

Saint Charles Updates:

I have immensely enjoyed our **Topics on Tuesday** gatherings in the church hall after the Tuesday morning Mass. It has provided an opportunity for us to get to know one another better and to share our thoughts on topics that matter to us as a parish family and as people of faith. I'm especially grateful for the presence of the Brothers of the Sacred Heart who live within the shadow of Saint Charles and generously support our activities with their presence and their encouragement. (Our parish is also blessed by the presence and ministry of a handful of religious women, including Sr. Jacqueline Dickey.) If you haven't joined us yet, please plan on doing so this week. And thanks, too, to parish leadership for continuing to provide us weekly with information regarding the parish life and ministry of Saint Charles. It's important to keep the lines of communication clear and open! I'm grateful to them for facilitating that process so well. As always, if you have any questions or concerns, do not hesitate to speak with me, our trustees or any member of our parish finance council.

NEW COMMUNION WARE:

Members of the parish have repeatedly requested a return to the practice of offering both species of Eucharistic communion at All Saints. We recently purchased affordable yet **dignified vessels** for that purpose, as refinishing the ones we already owned was cost prohibitive. If you would like to memorialize these vessels as gifts to the parish in honor of a deceased loved one, please contact the rectory. There are two chalices and a paten which can be memorialized individually by separate donors or memorialized as a set by one donor. We will return at All Saints to the practice of Communion under both species in the Fall.
