Someone sent me recently a CNN website containing 10 points for happiness given by Pope Francis in an interview with an Argentine journalist. Without attempting to give all ten of them, let me mention four of them. Pope Francis tells us to live and let live. That may sound very secular to us, but it is right from the mouth of the Lord himself who told us not to iudge others (Mt 7 and Lk 6) and we will not be judged. But what does that mean? Certainly I have to judge all the time. I believe the Lordand the pope—are thinking of what we used to call rash judgments, that is, judgments which we make without sufficient evidence or reflection on our part. Instead we should be slow to judge, and we should also, as far as is possible, give the other person the benefit of the doubt.

Pope Francis also calls us to move gently in the world. That is advice especially for the older people among us. Life should have taught us to be a little more careful with our words and actions.

Sunday, the pope says, should have two purposes: to be with family and to have leisure time. It is August. It has been the custom in France to take August off. The pope would obviously like that idea. I wonder if we here in the USA could do something like that but leave more flexibility in the time schedule lest our highways be too busy in one month. Could we work with both July and August?

The pope also urges us to let go of negatives. Don't nurture grudges. Yes, that is very good advice. We will burden ourselves if we nurture grudges and never learn to live a life of forgiveness, and such a life is an absolute necessity for a follower of Jesus.

Thank God for Pope Francis. He gives us such good advice.
