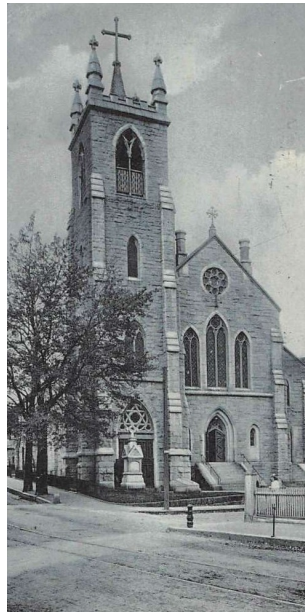

Con amor te presento, Señor, lo mejor de mi vida
 Con amor te presento, oh Señor, lo mejor de mi vida
 Como sacerdote, uno de los momentos más poderosos para mí durante la celebración de la misa es el ofertorio. Los fieles presentan sus ofrendas: los frutos de sus labores junto con el pan y el vino, símbolos de sus propias vidas. Tengo el gran honor de recibir esos regalos y ponerlos en el altar, presentándolos a Dios mismo. Este momento fue aún más conmovedor para mí el domingo pasado cuando nos reunimos en la misa de la 12 en Todos los Santos. Nuestro talentoso coro cantó las palabras bellas y conmovedoras: "Con amor te presento, Señor, lo mejor de mi vida... te presento, Señor, mi esperanza... Con mi ofrenda también yo te doy lo mejor de mis lágrimas. Te presento, Señor, mi dolor..." "Con amor te presento, Oh Señor, lo mejor de mi vida ... Te presento mis esperanzas ... Con mi ofrenda te doy la mayor de mis lágrimas. Te presento, oh Señor, mi dolor". ¡Qué hermosa oración de ofrenda!

Cuando nos reunimos el domingo pasado para recomendar a Dios el hijo de uno de nuestros feligreses que había muerto repentina y trágicamente varias semanas atrás, estas palabras adquirieron un significado aún mayor. Solo hay algunas heridas, pérdidas y penas tan profundas que no podemos evitar simplemente dárselas a Dios, entregárselas con fe y esperar que en sus manos podamos liberarnos de su carga y que se pueda obtener algo de gracia. Trabajé en y a través de ellos. Pensé en eso mientras veía la procesión del ofertorio del domingo: el pueblo de Dios presentando sus ofrendas, el pan y el vino, junto con ellos mismos, heridos, afligidos, cansados pero llenos de fe, esperanza y amor. Qué honor y privilegio poder como sacerdote recibir esos dones, descargar las cargas del pueblo de Dios en el altar y colocarlos en las manos heridas de Aquel que prometió hacer nuevas todas las cosas.

Hablando de los esfuerzos de la Iglesia para ministrar a los corazones afligidos y heridos, me complace anunciar que la Hna. Jackie Dickey, SSCh., se ha unido gentilmente para servir en el Ministerio de Duelo en nuestra parroquia. Hna. Jackie tiene muchos años de experiencia en el servicio diocesano, alcance comunitario y ministerio parroquial. Ella acompañará a las familias de los feligreses fallecidos a través del proceso de planificación de los ritos funerarios. Sé que ella será una presencia de apoyo, consuelo y paz. ¡Gracias, Hna. Jackie, por su disposición a servir en esta capacidad!
