St. Charles Parish - Tags will be hung on the garland inside rear of the church on October 27th. Please use the sign in sheet to put the tag number you choose and your name. Return purchased gift by November 25, 2018 at same location.

All Saints Parish - Tags will be hung on November 3rd on the garland under the windows. Returned presents may be placed in front of the statue of the Sacred Heart, which is on the left side of the altar by November 25th, 2018.

Each tag represents a present that an underprivileged Woonsocket child, age 12 and under, is hoping to receive on Christmas. There are over 300 tags with different price ranged. I encourage you to look through the tags and find one that fits your budget. We have an opportunity, as a parish family, to join together and lighten the hearts of those struggling in so many different ways this Christmas season. If you can, please pick up a tag today. Then in the coming weeks purchase the item listed on the tag and wrap it. It's very important that this tag is secured to the present so we can get the right present to the right child. Please have the presents in by Nov 25th because on Monday morning we start shopping for the missing gifts. So to save the parish money from purchasing duplicate gifts that have already been generously bought by yourself we ask that they are delivered on time. We greatly appreciate your cooperation.
