I met individually with trustees Bob Camara and Leslie Page prior to the distribution of copies of the decrees, and we all commented again on what a difficult process this has been. We will do whatever can to ensure that our upcoming events (information on all these events can be found elsewhere in the bulletin) will honor the legacy of Saint Charles Church. I am especially looking forward to our final Christmas Concert and Banquet on December 15 at **2pm.** Save the date now! Please be aware that while the concert is open to all, the banquet afterward will be a ticketed event.

In other news, I am very excited to be serving as Spiritual Director on a SEARCH retreat weekend at the Rejoice in Hope Youth Center in Cranston the weekend of December 6-8. An exceptional group of young people have been working under the guidance of Leo Fontaine (including his daughter, Juliette, who cantors at All Saints) to prepare what I am sure will be a powerful encounter with the Lord. 
